Our sincere condolences to the Whatuira-Kaimoana whanau for their loss. May Krucial rest in eternal peace. Moe mai ra e tama.

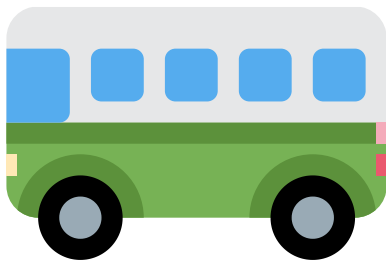
